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Vorbemerkungen:

Die hier vorgelegte "Fassung 'für synthetisches Orchester'" dient, wie im Falle des Vorgängerwerkes dazu, mittels der kommerziellen Softwaren "Sibelius", "Aria Player" und "Garritan Private Orchestra 4.0" die auf meiner Website [markuslepper.eu](http://markuslepper.eu) veröffentlichte Klangversion zu produzieren.

Die Partitur ist in **klingend = in C = suoni reali** notiert.

Ich danke besonders den beiden Freunden KH und MW, die mir ihr Domizil und das dortselbst befindliche Computersystem zur Verfügung gestellt hatten.

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Alle grundlegenden Bemerkungen, wie ausgeführt im Vorwort zum Vorgängerwerk, gelten hier unverändert.

Die ersten drei Sätze erklingen *attacca*; das Scherzo wird nach dem Trio unverändert wiederholt.

Ergänzend sei mitgeteilt, dass bei dem in verschiedenen Werken fundamental wichtigen CHORAL (op.37, op.40a, und nun hier) stets nur die Textstrophe "Wenn ich einmal soll scheiden" gemeint ist.

Ausserdem sei darauf hingewiesen dass *alle Wiederholungen obligatorisch sind*, auch die im Scherzo beim zweiten Erklingen.

Wegen eines Umfangs-Problemen musste das Kontrafagott (anders als die anderen Instrumente) von den "eingebauten Sibelius-Sounds" realisiert werden musste. Das verursacht deutlich abweichende Bedeutung der hier notierten Lautstärkeangaben.




